T'm on the call. 8 9 TRUSTEE LAWSON: Okay. Great, great. All 10 right. Well, with that being said, unless there is 11 a proclivity for a break, we can keep moving 12 because this Committee has a very, very short 13 update that I can give without anyone from staff 14 and we really don't have anything to vote on. So 15 Jenny, if you could, please, if you could call the 16 roll, we can convene this committee. 17 MS. BURY: Okay. Ms. Royster is on. And, 18 also, AD Overton is in the room as well. 19 TRUSTEE LAWSON: Great. Okay. So roll call, 20 please. 21 MS. ROYSTER: Trustee Grable. 22 TRUSTEE GRABLE: Present. 23 MS. ROYSTER: Trustee Graham. 24 (NO RESPONSE). 25 MS. ROYSTER: Trustee Lawrence.

5 1 TRUSTEE LAWRENCE: Here 2 MS. ROYSTER: Trustee Dortch. 3 TRUSTEE DORTCH: Here. 4 MS. ROYSTER: Chair, we have a quorum. 5 Thank you. Thank you. TRUSTEE LAWSON: 6 Ladies and gentlemen, today I want to just 7 give you a very brief update and share with you 8 what the next steps regarding athletics. 9 The big I guess guestion around athletics, and 10 I think AD Overton has done a great job of making 11 an attempt to answer, was really: What is our 12 current revenue projection for the coming year and 13 how does that play into addressing the budget 14 deficit that AD Overton walked into when he came on 15 campus? There's also -- that's one question that's 16 a question for this Committee and a question for 17 the Board. 18 There's also a third question, and that is 19 from the Board of Governors, and that question is: 20 Has our Board seen, reviewed and approved, first, 21 the revenue projections and then, second, the debt 22 reduction plan? 23 So what we have asked AD Overton to do in

conjunction with the Rattler Boosters, in conjunction with Mr. Cotton, in conjunction with

reviewing all of the above with the President is work on those two topics. Today, as opposed to 3 presenting something to you that's not 100% ready, we are choosing to delay the presentation of those details and present those to you in the form of a Committee meeting at a later date; and then, in turn, have our Committee review and potentially 8 approve that plan, for that plan to be reviewed 9 with the full Board for approval at our March meeting. Because what we need to be in a position to do first, as a committee, is review and approve 12 the plan; secondarily, as a board, to review and 13 approve the plan such that when the Board of 14 Governors reconvenes, assuming we're all in full alignment, the high-level details of our revenue 16 projection and our debt reduction plan can be 17 shared at the Board of Governors because, for those 18 of you that were in attendance at the most recent 19 Board of Governors meeting, that was clearly a callout.

21 So what Vice President Cassidy and I were able 22 to do is go back through the Board of Governors 23 meeting minutes to determine specifically what they 24 need and what their requirements are so that we're 25 on point with addressing their questions and

concerns. So long story short, there is not a formal update today, but I did want to share with you what the next steps are.

There will be a meeting of this Committee at a later date to work with Mr. Overton, AD Overton to review in detail those two components of the next steps, again, the revenue generation plan, as well as the overall debt reduction plan driven out of that, you know, one-year revenue generation plan. And you will see a subsequent plan over the next five years to address, you know, what we have been labeling as a deficit in the athletic department.

13 And, you know, there is probably a need to 14 really clarify, you know, how we really look from 15 an athletic funding and budget standpoint versus 16 other universities in the SUS. So we want to come 17 to you with a more comprehensive discussion versus 18 bits and pieces today. So are there any 19 questions -- so that was the update. Are there any 20 specific questions or general questions on where we 21 are?

TRUSTEE LAWRENCE: I have none.

23TRUSTEE LAWSON: Okay. Great. And, again,24we will reconvene and I will work with the25appropriate staff to properly notice the meeting

and have AD Overton share with you all of the specific details that, you know, we will need to align to as well as, again, taking them in front of the body of our peers, via the full Board, for alignment as well.
