I. University Advancement & B.O.T. Goals


- Strategic Goal: Enhance Institutional Fundraising and its established goal of \$5.5MM.
- Goal Achievement Status: YTD (beginning of 3rd Quarter) \$4.1 million in cash and \$8.3 million in cash and pledges.
- Fundraising Initiatives & gifts:
 - Giving to Florida A&M University has increased by 72% over last year.
 - Multi-million Dollar Gift and Six Figure Bequests (\$5 million major gift; over \$250,000 in planned gifts)
 - > 2014 Faculty & Staff (\$194,410.00) [Cash & Pledges]
 - ➤ Over 5,000 Donors 131.99% increase in donors over last year this time;
 - > Total fundraising to-date exceeds \$8.3 Million in cash and pledges

- Continue focus on acquiring, repeating and upgrading donors
- Expand stewardship initiatives to include New Donor Welcome Package/Kit and Scholarship Donor Recognition event
