FAMU Transfer Requirements

Please Note: In order to be admitted in the College of Education a student must have earned a C or above and a 2.5 GPA in the 36 hours of their general education Core classes; have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative GPA; and have passed the Florida Teacher Certification Test of General Knowledge. Students who are able to do those things before transferring to FAMU have a much smoother transition to the major rather than having to remain in the pre-major for more than a semester.
