FAMU Transfer Requirements

Please Note: Division of Journalism students are required to complete a minimum of 125 semester hours to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Journalism or Public Relations. A student must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to be admitted to the program. To graduate, a student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.4 and a minimum 2.5 GPA in major courses.

In order to be admitted in the School of Journalism and Graphic Communication student must have a minimum of 2.5 cumulative GPA and have earned at least an "A" and/or a "B" in ENC 1101 and ENC 1102. Students who are able to do those things before transferring to FAMU have a much smoother transition to the major rather than having to remain in the pre-major for more than a semester.
