## 2.033 Student Affairs – Mandatory Health Insurance

- (1) A mandatory student health insurance program for students at Florida A&M University will be implemented in the 2016-2017 academic year. Beginning with the June 2016 Summer B term, all students who are enrolled at least half-time in a degree-granting program at any campus of Florida A&M University will be required to provide proof of adequate health insurance as a condition of enrollment.
  - (a) Students may satisfy this requirement with personally acquired health insurance coverage that meets benefit requirements established by the University and the Affordable Care Act.
  - (b) Students without appropriate coverage will be enrolled in the University-sponsored insurance program.
